Sick & Emergency Backup Childcare (SCP/EBCP)	The Backup Care Program (BCP) is an important work/life service for the University of Arizona (UA) community. This program runs July 1, 2023 - June 30, 2024, and provides up to 80 hours of backup care for dependents and qualifying relatives of full benefits eligible employees through a contracted vendor. Backup care does not include skilled medical or long-term care. The dependent or qualifying relative must meet the criteria stated in the IRS Publication 501. Backup care services may only be used on the same day(s) as an employee's work-related commitments.
